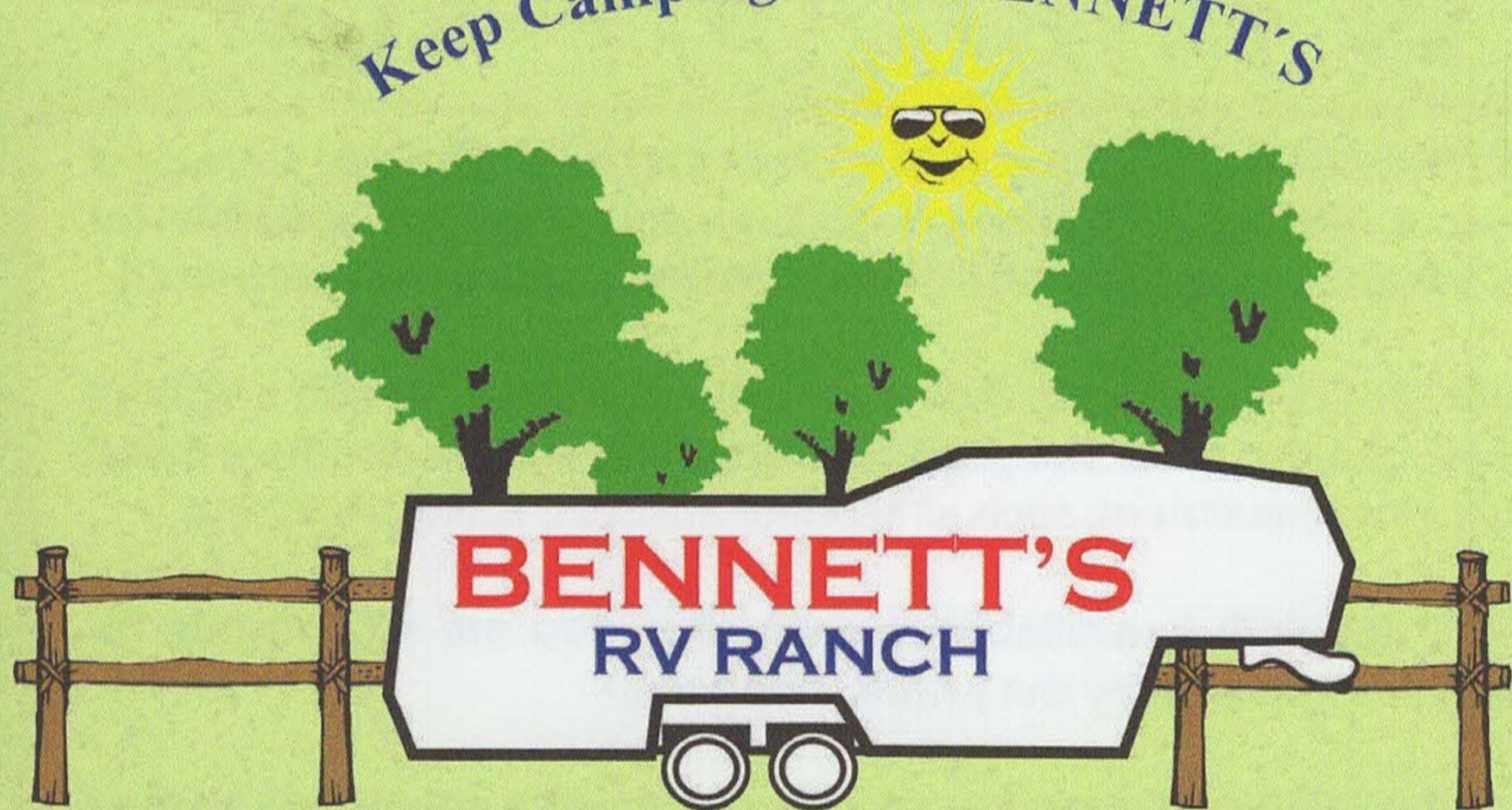

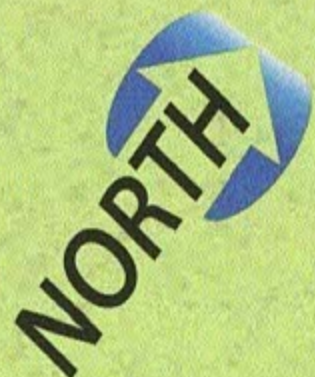

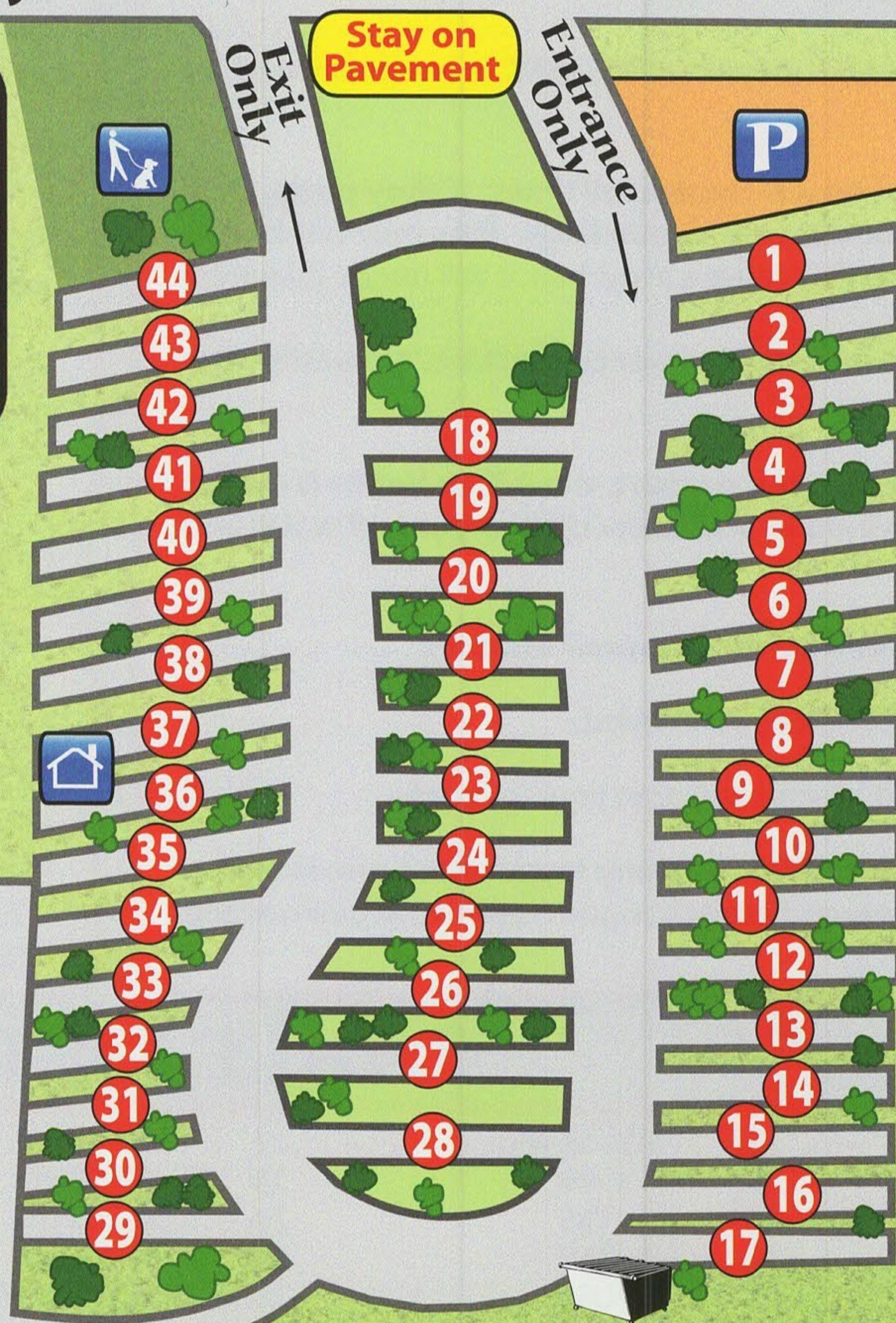

GUIDELINES FOR A SAFE & ENJOYABLE STAY

CHECK-IN TIME 2 PM/CHECK-OUT TIME 12 PM: If staying past your paid-through date, please confirm space availability at the office. Rates are for up to 2 people per site. All rent is due in advance. No Refunds will be given at any time for any reason.

OCCUPANCY/PARKING: Please display park pass in your window. One RV & one vehicle per site. No parking on grass or roadway. Additional parking available by the entrance. Vehicles not used daily, like boats, trailers, etc., need to be put in storage either at Bennett's or somewhere else. Empty sites are for rent, vehicles parked there will pay full site fee.

QUIET HOURS: Daily 10:00 PM-7:00 AM. Please respect your neighbors; no generators due to noise.

SPEED LIMIT 5 MPH: Please obey the **ONE-WAY** street policy and do not drive through sites.

PETS: They must be kept **on a 6' leash** at all times. If **they poop**, then **you scoop**. Pets are **not allowed** in buildings. Pets may not be left outside unattended. Pets that cause a disturbance will not be tolerated.

SEWER HOSE SEALS: Use an airtight sewer connection. No wastewater is to run on the ground.

BATHHOUSE/LAUNDRY: For your comfort, the A/C or heater is always on so please keep the windows and doors closed. Turn off water and lights when done.

TRASH DISPOSAL: See site map for dumpster location.

FIREARMS & FIREWORKS: Strictly Prohibited.

ALCOHOL: Please keep it at your site or in your unit only.

RV & VEHICLE WASHING/REPAIRS: Washing is permitted provided you pay \$5 per vehicle in advance. No oil changes, repairing or overhauling of vehicle allowed.

SITE APPEARANCE: Keep your site clean and neat. Outside storage of personal items is not allowed. Storage buildings are available for additional fee. Inquire at the office. **Clotheslines** are not permitted.

TREES/GRASS/PAVEMENT: Please do not cut trees or attach anything to them. Do not cover the grass with anything and do not drive metal objects into pavement, such as satellite anchors, spikes, nails, etc.

PHONE SERVICE: Is available at each site. You are responsible for having it hooked up by the phone company.

WINTER MONTHS: You will be required to insulate your water hose as well as the hydrant at your site. If you choose not to insulate it, you must unhook your hose from the hydrant when the temperature falls below freezing. This is so that the valve and your hose won't freeze and burst. If the hydrant leaks or bursts, you will be charged to replace it.

NO SMOKING PERMITTED IN ANY BUILDINGS

NOTICE: Wind my cause sprinklers to over spray onto pad. Please remove anything that may be damaged by water.

By entering and/or paying any fee, guests agree to the campground rules and conditions and are responsible for the repair/replacement cost of any damage caused by them or their visitors.

Follow these steps to get cable TV 1. Hook up your cable from the pedestal to your coach. 2. Go to your TV's menu and auto scan for cable TV Channels

INTERNET CONNECTION

- Plug in one end of the Ethernet cable into the pedestal (opposite side of the power cord connection. It will not fit in the telephone jack.
- Plug the other end of the Ethernet cord into the Ethernet port on your computer.
- You will need to disable the wireless connection and set your computer for a local area connection or also called a LAN connection.
- If you need e-mail you can get a free e-mail account online from many companies such as hotmail, windows live mail or yahoo mail.
- No passwords are required to use the internet.
- Ethernet cables are available for free use, just ask for one at the office. Please bring it back to the office when checking out or return to the portable building between sites 36 & 37.

FAQ:

Q: Why do I need to use an Ethernet cord?

A: WiFi requires line of sight from your computer to the transmitting antenna and because of where the transmitting antenna is and the beautiful trees in the park, WiFi loses signal and will drop your connection.

Q: I have a connection without the Ethernet cord, all I need is a password?

A: You are receiving a WiFi signal that will drop your connection.

Initially WiFi signal strength was tested in the park and we found it to be a very unreliable because of the beautiful trees blocking the signal. If your internet connection/computer is asking for a password, disable the wireless connection and set your network settings for a local area connection for LAN then connect the Ethernet cable.
